As a Tampa Bay Area Career Pathways Consortium (TBCPC) County School student ([Hernando](#), [Hillsborough](#), [Manatee](#), [Pasco](#), [Pinellas](#), [Polk](#) and [Sarasota](#) County Schools), you may receive FREE college credit for high school and technical programs, through a partnership between Hillsborough Community College, Pasco-Hernando State College, Polk State College, St. Petersburg College, and State College of Florida (Manatee-Sarasota) and the participating School Board. Your free credits may be applied to certificates and associate of science degrees provided you meet the requirements outlined in the partnership agreements.

#### To receive credit:

1. Enroll in one of the career, technical or academy programs at your school.
2. Complete the program with a B average of better and earn an overall unweighted GPA of 2.5 or better.
3. Meet with your school counselor to complete an articulation form for one of the TBCPC participating colleges.
4. Sign and mail the completed form to the TBCPC participating College.
5. Enroll at a TBCPC participating College in the certificate or associate of science degree program that correlates with your high school or technical school program within three years of taking the class or classes.
